Process for Developing the Teachscape Professional Learning Plan

Step 4: Set target dates to review progress periodically and make necessary adjustments to PLP.

Step 5: Implement the PLP and collect evidence of learning and work completed.

Step 6: Monitor progress of the PLP and assess using the professional learning rubric at each scheduled review date.
